

CSU UNITS

What is a CSU UNIT? CSU stands for Crisis Stabilization Unit. A place which is suppose to be a good environment for you to improve your mind. But, is it? A person gets & stays well by serving others. Such as a person working at a job, serves others and provides for their needs. But how can this be done in a CSU unit. Everyone, seems to be provide for by the CSU staff members. What patient can provide for another persons needs? Yes, there is a lack of work for a mentally ill person on the Unit. If a person is not well because they were not functioning at a Job, what if anything will a CSU do, to rehab the person, so that he/she can return to work? Some CSU units do nothing! There seems to just be the trend to do nothing, take med's, enjoy food to eat, and watch TV all day long, or perhaps sleep. This is all fine, but this type of lifestyle does little to help a person recover from their illness. Then it gets worse enjoying and/or coveting other people live's. When you are on the unit, you must not ask for much for yourself, for the staff are not doing well either, mostly because they think that they are better than the patients in life, and some even believe that they are god, and can do whatever they want to whomever they like, and there would never be any consequences from what they do, believing that it's their job, and they are required to do it! Some mental health personnel, treat other's poorly, perhaps not other staff members, but concentrate on treating mental patients poorly. But, I feel sorry for the staff people. They have a poor choice of employment to fulfill. This is because only Jesus improves a person's life. Another sinner can only make a small improvement to a persons life, or even have their life improved by the patient. Jesus is the only way to improve a persons life. But when Jesus or his thoughts are mentioned, great amounts of noise start to happen on the unit, perhaps trying to block out Jesus and/or thoughts like him. Is a CSU unit a place for staff members to improve or for mental patients to improve. Not that I can ever pay for the \$40000.00 bill that I have been given, for (2) one month stay's on the CSU unit. They must like me. But, of course you do not need to be doing anything wrong to be committed to a unit, for I was taken while I was resting on my couch at home. Someone, was worried about me. Perhaps, someone who does not trust in Jesus for their life! Needless to say, I am home again having fun. But, I can always be locked up again, if it pleases these non-Jesus authorities. I don't care what has happened to me. And, if it happened to Jesus, he would not care either. Now I'm being attacked financially from Hospital's & Mental Health facilities, in which, they are not doing financially well, and require me to pay for their forced / on involuntarily provisions. I could have just as easily have stayed at home, and not have incurred these rather large bills. But, as I have said these authorities were not from Jesus, and they acted on an authority, which these authorities were use to, and it was normal for them to use their group authority, to have a person go through a treatment plan. However, you must say & do only the best, and rationalistic behavior while on the unit. Never, never, never, threaten any persons life regardless of why, or what happened to you. Talk & act like Jesus, and do what Jesus would do, and eventually they will grow tired of confining you at the CSU. There is a shortage of Life on the unit, because Jesus is a discussion in which is shunned, and avoided, so there tends to be an abundance of life, which is of a poorer quality, because Jesus is the higher quality of life. And, it's hard to find another person on the unit who will talk about Jesus openly, for this subject is banned from conversations, and people fear the consequences if they talk about Jesus! But, for me it's all a humbling experience, and CSU units help me be closer to Jesus, for Jesus is my Hero, and he rescues me from difficult situations, in which I can not save myself. Sometimes, there is great violence on the unit, when two patients fight with each other, or when a patient fights with the staff...Is this a wholesome environment for a person with problems, to be exposed to? Do you really think that by using a medication, that a person's sinful life will improve? Jesus, and/or his people, are the only hope for a person to recover from life losses. And Jesus is the only way to have your sin paid for, and healing to happen in your life. Other ways of healing are false, and do not do much to help you..It is good to pray for each other, and wish them well, prayers do help some.
