

## Little children are more like Jesus than adults are!

**Mat 18:1** At the same time came the disciples unto Jesus, saying, Who is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven?

**Mat 18:2** And Jesus called a little child unto him, and set him in the midst of them,

**Mat 18:3** And said, **Verily I say unto you, Except ye be converted, and become as little children, ye shall not enter into the kingdom of heaven.**

**Mat 18:4** **Whosoever therefore shall humble himself as this little child, the same is greatest in the kingdom of heaven.**

**Mat 18:5** **And whoso shall receive one such little child in my name receiveth me.**

Little children do not care about what most adults have cared about. They do not have the cares of the world. They are not worried about accomplishing a change in how things are. They are happy with how things are. They tend to let the world do what it wants to do, and not interfere. They may be happy playing games, and not be worried, about how things are. While most adults, have grown into caring about work, money, material possessions, or other areas which seem important to them, but, in the eyes of Jesus, are foolishness. They do not do well in life, because they have cared about lesser things, and considered them to be more important.

**Mar 4:19** **And the cares of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches, and the lusts of other things entering in, choke the word, and it becometh unfruitful.**
